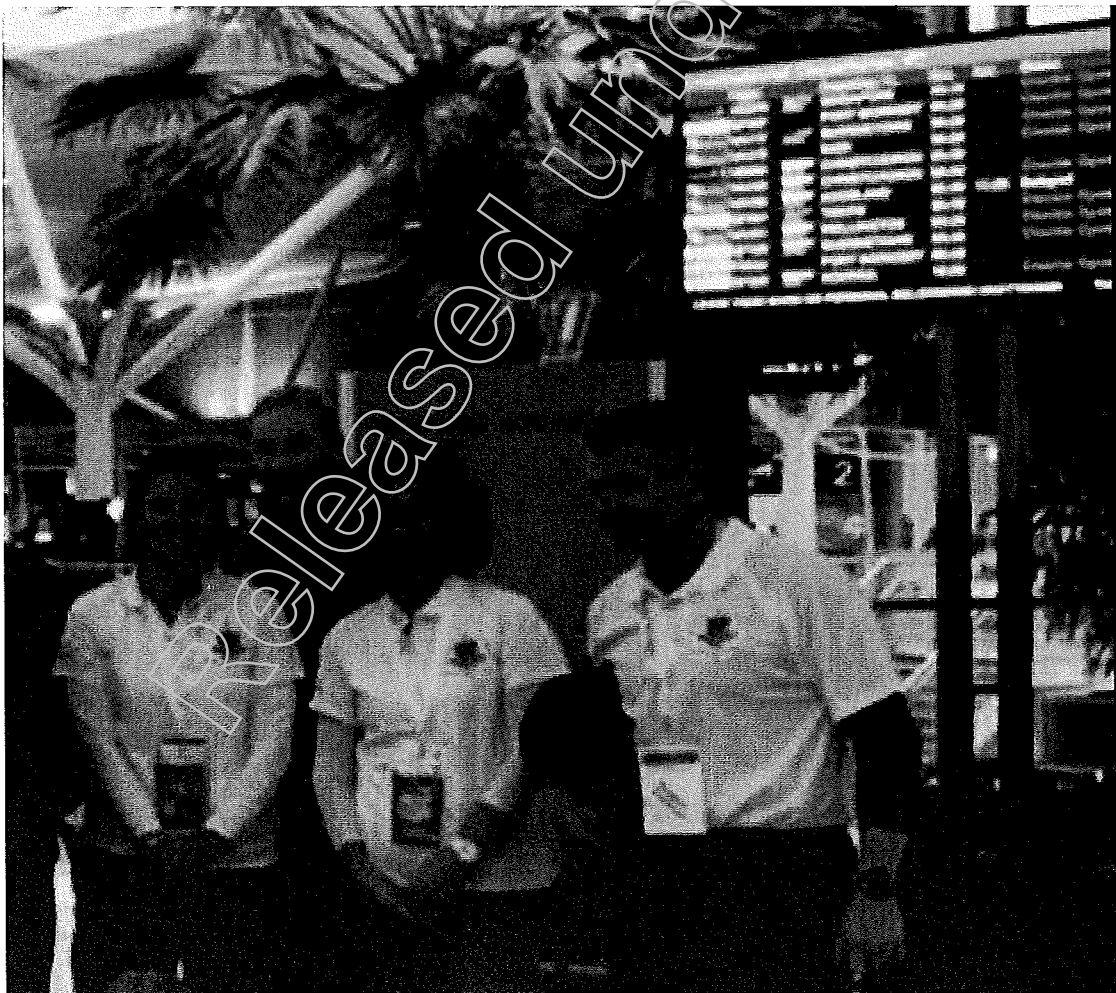

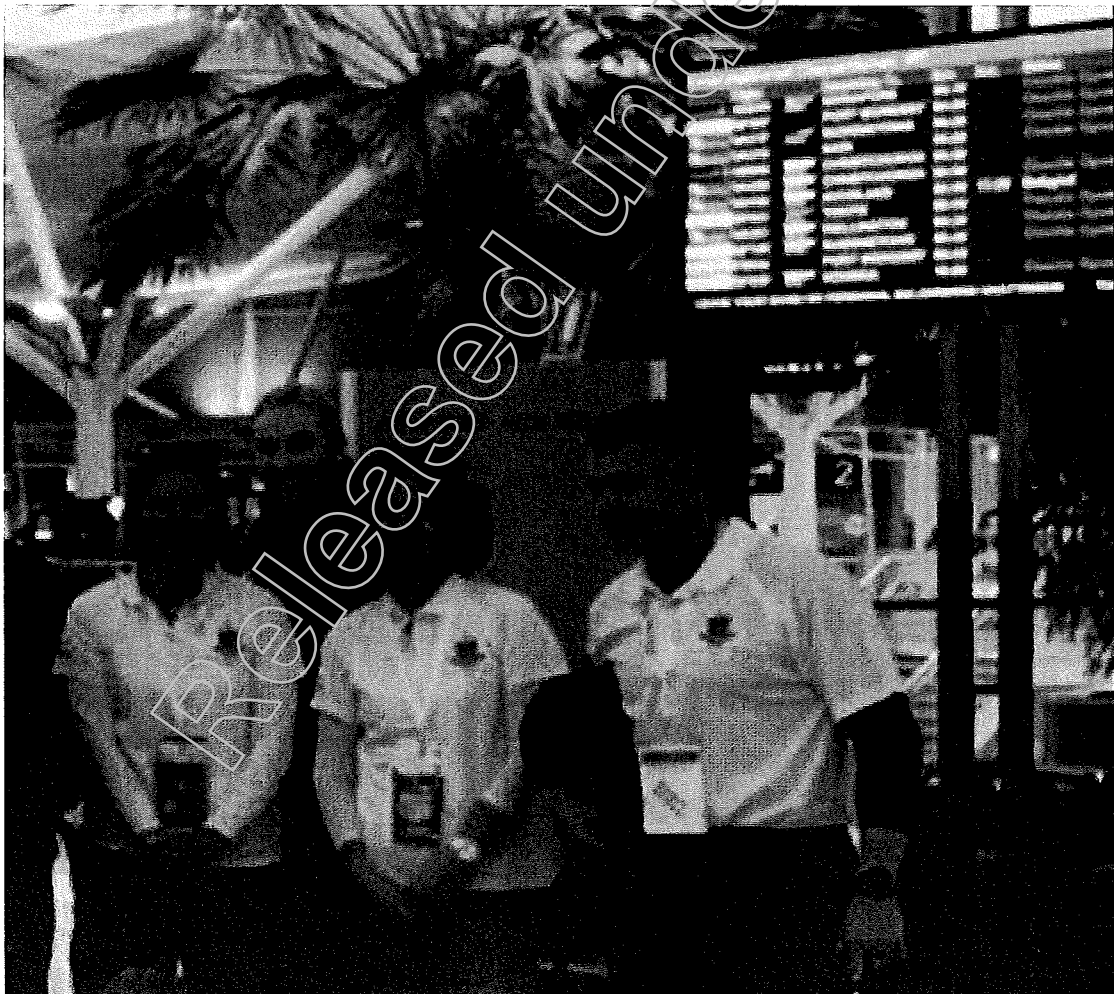

Watts. Are there more assaults in private prisons than in government-owned prisons? Peter Martin - hard to answer because the prisons are unique in size, in nature of prisoners, layout. My primary consideration is the safety of prisoners and staff. Prisons in Qld are complex dynamic places and there are no two prisons that are alike.

Watts: Prisons to all be privately run. Government view that publicly run prisons are safer. They have more staff therefore safety is enhanced and you address safety risk

Watts to Martin \$111m - is that just wages? it is the cost of staffing from private to public

Overcrowding - double-ups and bunk beds. When do you expect there to be relief of overcrowding. - overcrowding continues to be the major challenge. Not unique to Qld. Problem Australasia-wide. CCC Flaxton taskforce is an opportunity. SQCF to women has relieved overcrowding from 200% to 95%. New prison at SQCC phase 2 and Capricornia will address numbers

Does double bunking require additional staff for lock up and unlock? There is an agreement with government that as prisoner numbers increase there will be an increase in funding for staff.

In reference to Taskforce Flaxton overcrowding contributes to corruption. Reducing overcrowding but what other steps are being put in place to reduce corruption? - Recs in Flaxton working feverishly to implement recs. CCC has helped develop longer term strategic plan. Never had one before. Creating ethical standards unit sim to police. Will investigate but also put measures in place. HR leadership corruption resistant. Same with finance. Minister - dedicated line item in budget for addressing Flaxton.
