VULNERABLE SETTINGS - AGED CARE, HOSPITALS, PRISONS, DISABILITY SERVICES Example: hotels, pubs, clubs, taverns, bars, restaurants, cafes.	✓	✓	✗	Must not allow access to high-risk areas. Unvaccinated people can only be for the purposes of end of life, childcare, or emergency schooling.
HOSPITALITY VENUES Example: hotels, pubs, clubs, taverns, bars, restaurants, cafes.	✓	✓	✗	Only vaccinated staff and patrons permitted to enter. No Covid-19 density limits apply. (Where the objective, if serving with unvaccinated individuals - a maximum of 20 people in 1 per 4 square metres).
INDOOR ENTERTAINMENT VENUES Example: nightclubs, indoor live music venues, karaoke bars, concerts, theatres, cinemas.	✓	✓	✗	Only vaccinated staff and patrons permitted to enter. No Covid-19 density limits apply. (Where the objective, if serving with unvaccinated individuals - a maximum of 20 people in 1 per 4 square metres).
OUTDOOR ENTERTAINMENT ACTIVITIES Example: sports stadiums, theme parks.	✓	✓	✗	Only vaccinated staff and patrons permitted to enter. No Covid-19 density limits apply.
FESTIVALS (Indoor venue - indoor and outdoor) Example: folk festivals, arts festivals, music festivals.	✓	✓	✗	Only vaccinated staff and patrons permitted to enter. No Covid-19 density limits apply.
WEDDINGS (Indoor venue - indoor and outdoor)	✓	✓	✗	If any persons are unvaccinated, including the wedding party and others, a maximum of only 20 people can attend. No Covid-19 density limits apply where all attendees are vaccinated.
QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT OWNED GALLERIES, MUSEUMS AND LIBRARIES	✓	✓	✓	No Covid-19 density limits apply.
OTHER SETTINGS Such as essential retail, other retail, public transport, etc.	✓	✓	✓	Covid-19 density restrictions may still apply, as per Queensland's current COVID-19 Public Health Orders.
