

Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>The proposal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • broadens the senior executives under section 12 of the <i>Integrity Act 2009</i> that can seek the advice of the Integrity Commissioner, to ensure Queensland Police Service senior executive equivalents employed under the <i>Police Service Administration Act 1990</i> have the same rights as their senior executive colleagues employed under the <i>Public Sector Act 2022</i>, who are automatically captured; and • prescribes additional statutory office holders not captured in Schedule 1 of the <i>Integrity Act 2009</i>, to ensure the obligation to provide declarations of interest and conflicts of interest continues to apply to those office holders following the repeal of the <i>Public Sector Act 2008</i>. <p>The amendments do not increase costs or regulatory burden on business or the community and are unlikely to have adverse impacts. These amendments are not subject to regulatory impact analysis under <i>The Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i> as they relate to public sector management.</p>
